Vocabulary	Definition	Hue - a colour in its purest form Tone – the colour grey added to a hue to change its brightness Shade – a colour darkened with black Tint – a colour lightened with white 
7 Elements of Art	The 7 elements of art help us to create and talk about art.	
The 7 Elements of Art		
Line	The path left by a moving point e.g. a pencil or a brush dipped in paint.	
Shape	The outline of an area.	
Colour	Colour is a way that we describe an object based on the way that it reflects light.	
Tone	The lightness or darkness of something.	
Form	Form is a shape in three dimensions.	
Texture	The way something feels or looks like it feels – actual texture and visual texture.	
Space	Space is used to create depth.
