

## Message from the Headteacher

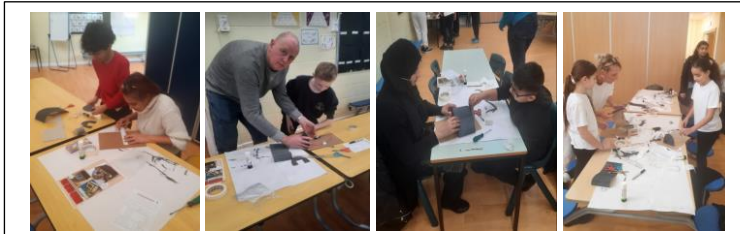
Dear Parents,

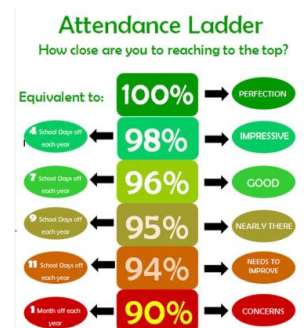
